According to the latest news from the Federal Council, the SNAC 2020 should be able to proceed normally in September.

The Swiss National Aerobatic Championship SNAC 2020 will take place in Bex from 6 th to the 13th of September 2020.

Registration:

Registration is open on the SAA website: https://www.saa.ch/snac-2020-registration/

You will find an online registration form, registration fee info and payment instructions. Sportsman benefit from an attractive registration fee discount.

Deadline is 30th of June. Please check the conditions for late registration on the website. IMPORTANT

- 1. On June 30, according registrations we'll decide if we start Sunday or Monday afternoon (even Tuesday morning). Late registrations could be refused according situation.
- 2. According SNAC Regulations 2020-1, a minimum of 3 participants is necessary to be ranked (points 3.3.2 & 3.3.3). At that date (May 3, 2020), Advanced and Excellence categories have not reached the minimum number of 3 registered pilots.

Don't forget to prepare the speaker information form and the doping consent form, latest on Sunday 6th of September at registration.

If this is your first competition you will find the SNAC a friendly and supportive environment to start your competition experience. So do not hesitate, you will enjoy the time.

I am looking forward to seeing many, many of you in Bex!

We have already reserved the rooms for judges and officials at Hôtel Le Cèdre in Bex.


I recommend that you quickly check out availability of accommodation in Bex and surroundings.
