Check out the airport website https://www.thun-airfield.ch. You will find information about LSZW. No customs are available at Thun AD.

Please adhere strictly to VAC instructions.

The VAC chart says preferred approaches are from N and S.

Do get in radio contact with Thun AD on 123.255 early enough to ensure a safe approach.

There will be many aircraft arriving around the same time on Monday morning. Upon arrival follow the instructions from the airport personnel (radio or hand signals) and proceed to the aircraft parking for competition aircrafts.





All UNL and SNFC pilots will need a valid low-level permit for 100 m/AGL. All ADV pilots need a valid low-level permit for 200 m/AGL (or lower). These can be obtained from FOCA.
